



## Single Vineyard Margelina 2017

**Grape varieties:** Field Blend

**Grape Origin:** Agios Nicolaos

**Classification:** P.G.I. Pafos

**Vineyard:** Sandy chalky soils at an altitude of 900m above sea level. Planted in 1921, these non-irrigated bush vines benefit from the cool breeze coming from the forest of the Troodos mountain range.

**Vinification:** All the 7 grape varieties planted in this centenarian vineyard were crushed together. The naturally occurring yeast fermented the wines at high temperature favouring colour extraction and flavour enrichment. The wine was aged for 6 months in old French barriques and bottled unfiltered and non-stabilised to retain its uniqueness. This wine style is a missing piece of the puzzle of the Cypriot wine industry.

**Tasting notes:** Ruby red colour with pomegranate colour rim. Intense aroma of black currants, red pepper and preserved red fruits.
